Legal base of a Europass fit for the digital age

- **Decision (EU) 2018/646** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 April 2018 on a common framework for the provision of better services for skills and qualifications (Europass) and repealing Decision No 2241/2004/EC

Europass will offer end users:

- *A free online profile to highlight skills, qualifications and experiences;*
- *Self-assessment of skills to help define career and learning goals;*
- *Tailored information on job and learning possibilities;*
- *Full control of personal data;*
- *Possibility to reuse data and autofill applications;*
- *Trustworthy digitally-signed credentials.*

A portfolio is a product and a process at the same time.

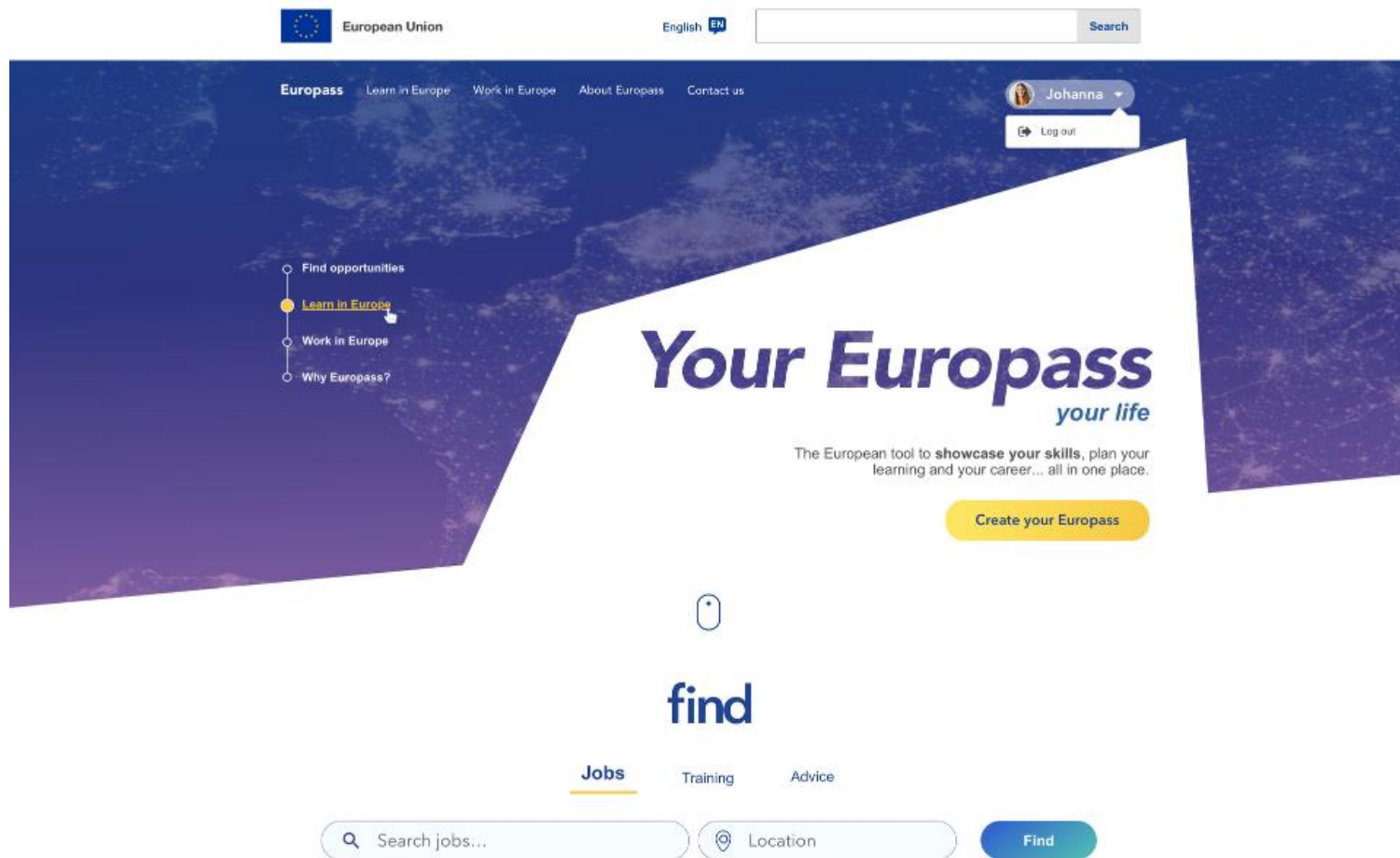
- Provide a single entry-point for a set of web-based tools;

- Create and edit documents such as CVs through an Online Editor;
- Define and keep track of interests, goals and aspirations;
- Provide suitable learning and job opportunities;
- Prepare, submit and keep track of learning and job applications.

Users will be able to:

- Record their skills and qualifications in an E-Profile;
- Collect relevant documents such as diploma, reference letters, motivation letters, CVs and digital credentials in a Library;
- Explore and configure how Europass analyses their skills;
- Control their personal data in their e-portfolio .

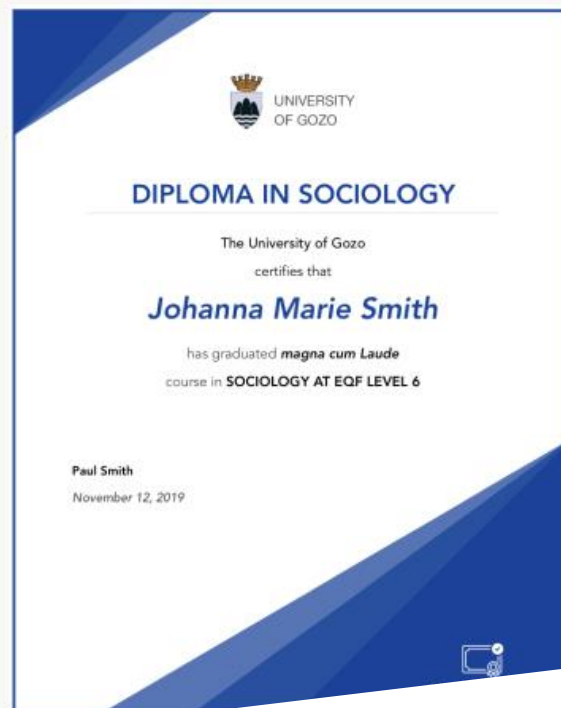
