




Guidelines for Swedish for Immigrants (SFI) at Different Level



My colleague Signe and I assist the studients att SFI, and we have chosen to allocate 1.5 positions for the SFI students, with myself att 100% and my colleague at 50%






The job market in Sweden can be challenging for those who do not master the Swedish language, and often a high school diploma is required, even for simpler jobs

- SFI is the foundation for further studies but also a prerequisite for understanding Swedish society
- You study 20 houers per week at SFI
- You can combine SFI with other courses based on needs and eligibility
- We have approximately 300 students in SFI
- Depending on the educational background of the student, they are placed on a study path
- We have three study paths in SFI
 - -Study Path 1: Students with little or non prior schooling. 0-5 years
 - -Study Path 2: Students with a schooling background of 5-12 years
 - -Study Path 3: Students with 13 years or more schooling background
- They are also level-placed depending on which level they are on A-D











What do we, as study and career counselors at SFI, do?

- Visit classes
- Individual meetings
- Study Planning
- Career Guidance
- Information Provision
- Support and Motivation
- Coordination with Other Resources





Specifically for SFI

- Most often, we have open doors where students can come in and ask questions abaut their studies
- The students always have opportunity to schedule appointments for longer discussions
- There is always the possibility of receiving interpreter assistance in one's native language.
- We try to map out previous educational background and work experience

- There is an opportunity to submit their previous educational experiences at the hig school and university levels for an assessment to determine how their prior studies correspond to the Swedish education system, which we encourage students to do
- The most common questions
 - Explaining letter and messages from authories
 - Student grants (somthing they must do themselves but we can explain the process)
 - Assistance with applications for further studies
